Al-Azhar's Impact

- Limited Research & Development infrastructure
- Much smaller than Harvard
- Library with a limited number of books
- 50+ notable personalities graduated in the last 1000+ years
- Very few influential people/thought leaders were produced in history, but no one in the modern world.
- No global organizations exist today which its graduates founded

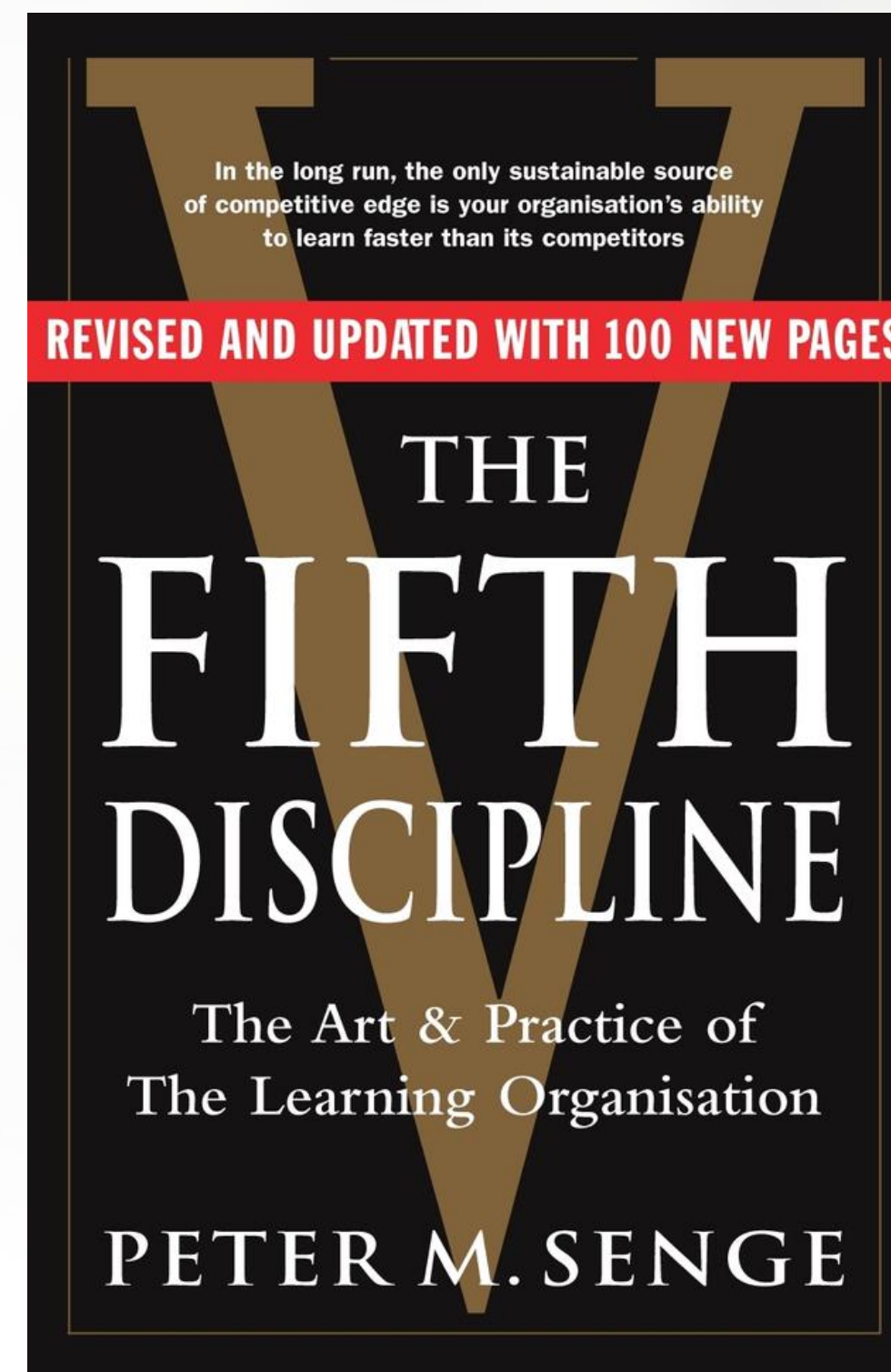

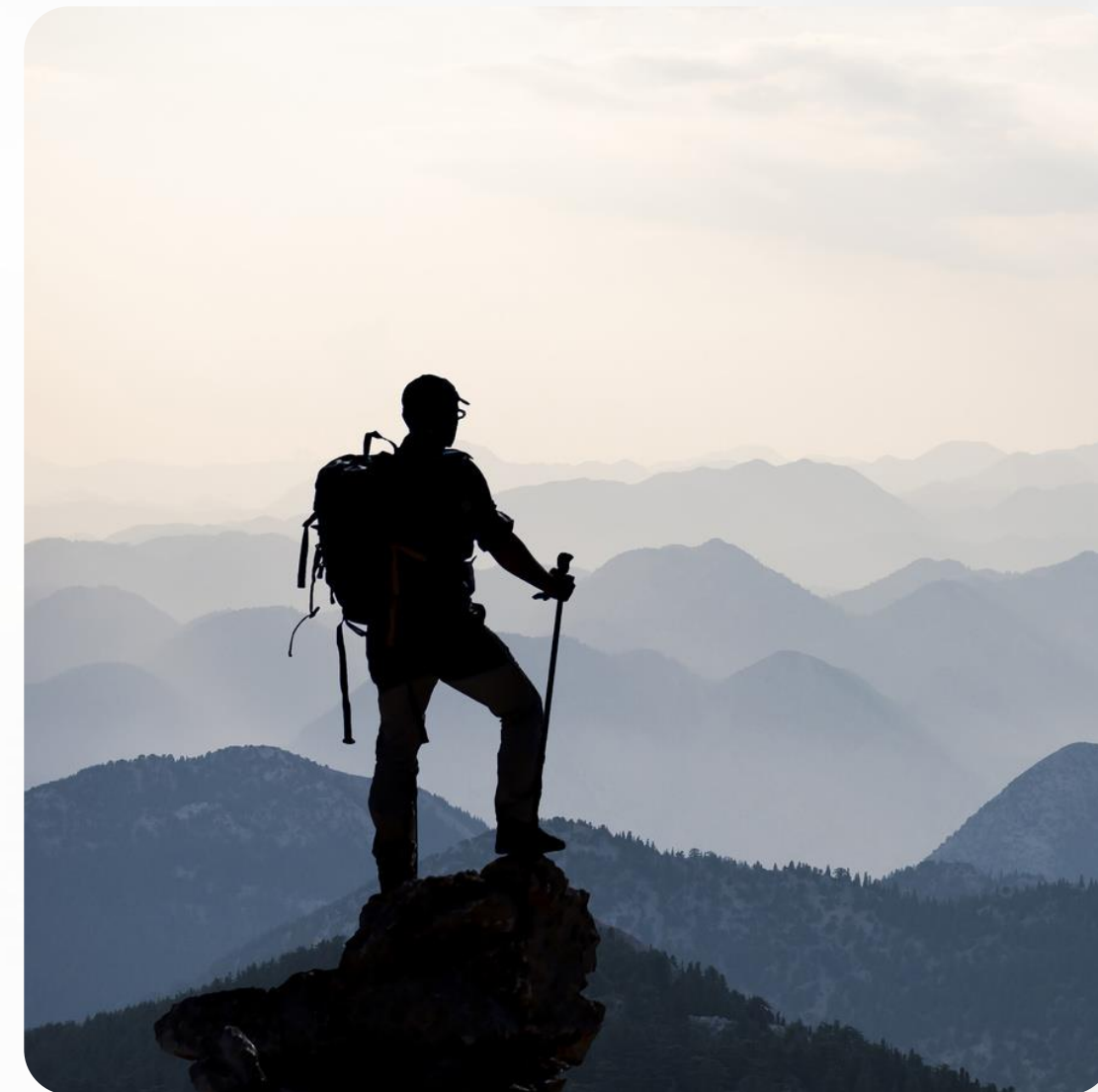

ULTIMATE VISION

An Ultimate Vision is a vision that is independent of time.

Abdur Rahman Ibn Awf (ra): The Richest Muslim Who Bought His Way to Jannah

When Abdur Rahman Ibn Awf (ra) passed away.

His net worth valued in Gold Coins was Three Billion One Hundred and Three Million Islamic Dinars (**3,103,000,000 – 4.25 gms gold per coin**).

If the whole wealth converted into USD then the calculation of Abdur Rahman Ibn Awf (ra) net worth is approximately **$3,103,000,000 \times 4.25 \times 48.48 = \text{USD } 639,342,120,000$**
i.e. ~ USD 639 billion

Jeff Bezos (founder of Amazon) is the richest person in the world as of July 2023 and his total net worth is around **USD 177 billion**, whereas, Abdur Rahman Ibn Awf (ra) stood at **USD 639 billion**.

LORD MACAULAY'S MINUTE ON INDIAN EDUCATION

FEB. 2, 1835

"We must at present do our best to form a class who may be interpreters between us and the millions whom we govern; a class of persons, Indian in blood and color, but English in taste, in opinions, in morals, and in intellect. To that class we may leave it to refine the vernacular dialects of the country, to enrich those dialects with terms of science borrowed from the Western nomenclature, and to render them by degrees fit vehicles for conveying knowledge to the great mass of the population."

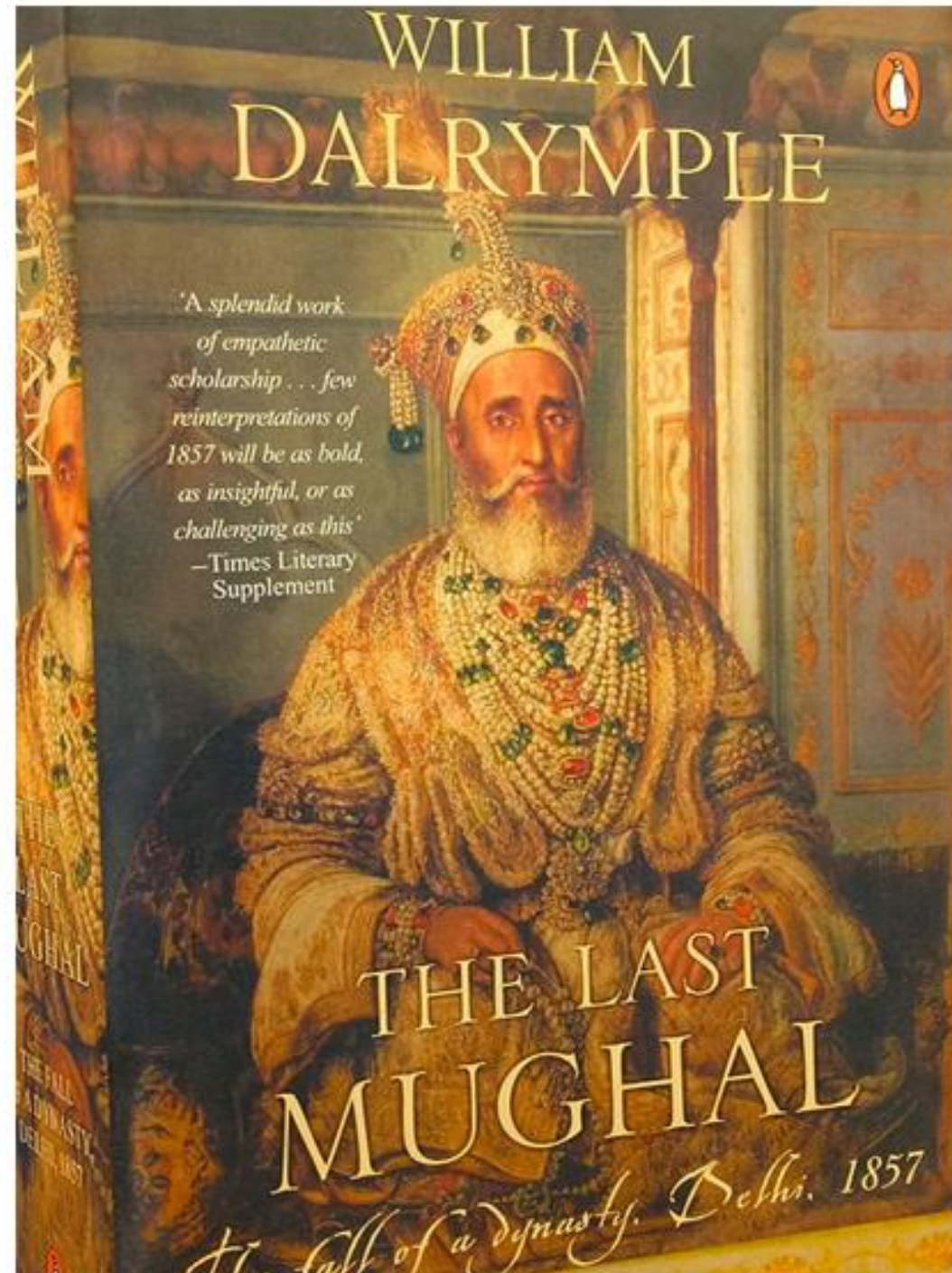


LORD MACCAULAY'S MINUTE ON INDIAN EDUCATION

FEB. 2, 1835

"I have conversed both here and at home with men distinguished by their proficiency in the Eastern tongues. I have never found one among them who could deny that a single shelf of a good European library was worth the whole native literature of India and Arabia. Honors might be roughly even in works of the imagination, such as poetry, but when we pass from works of imagination to works in which facts are recorded, and general principles investigated, the superiority of the Europeans becomes absolutely immeasurable."

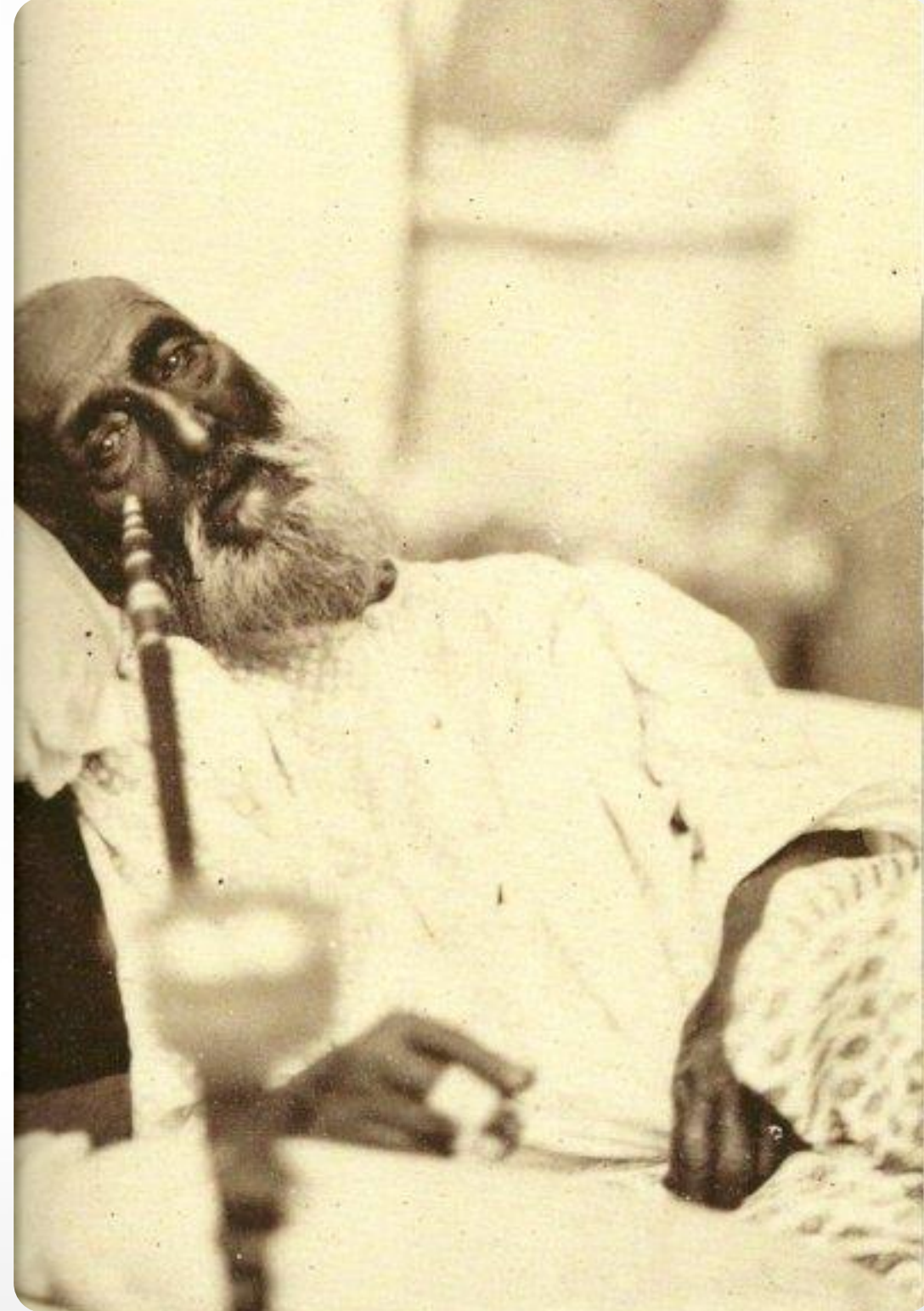


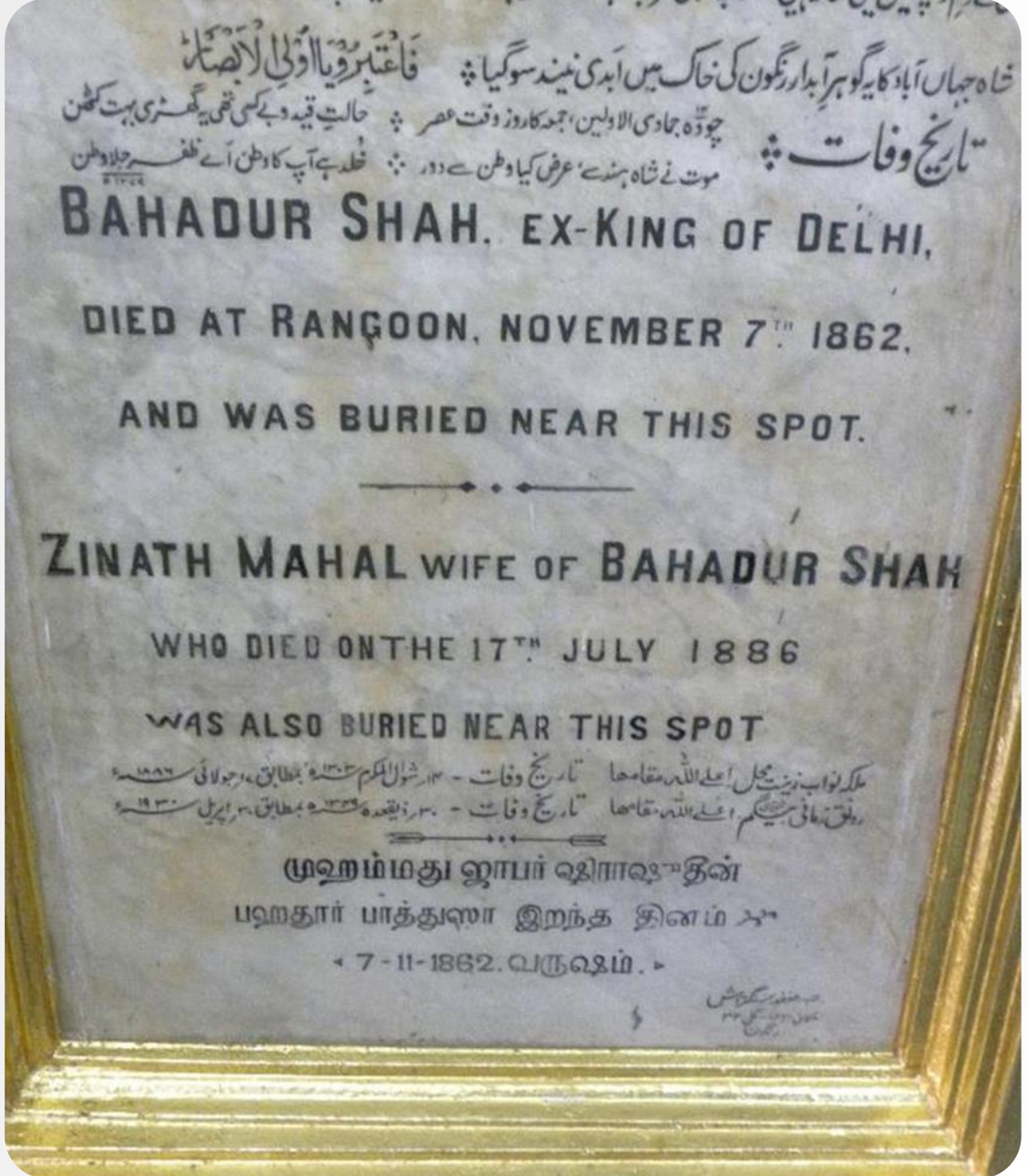

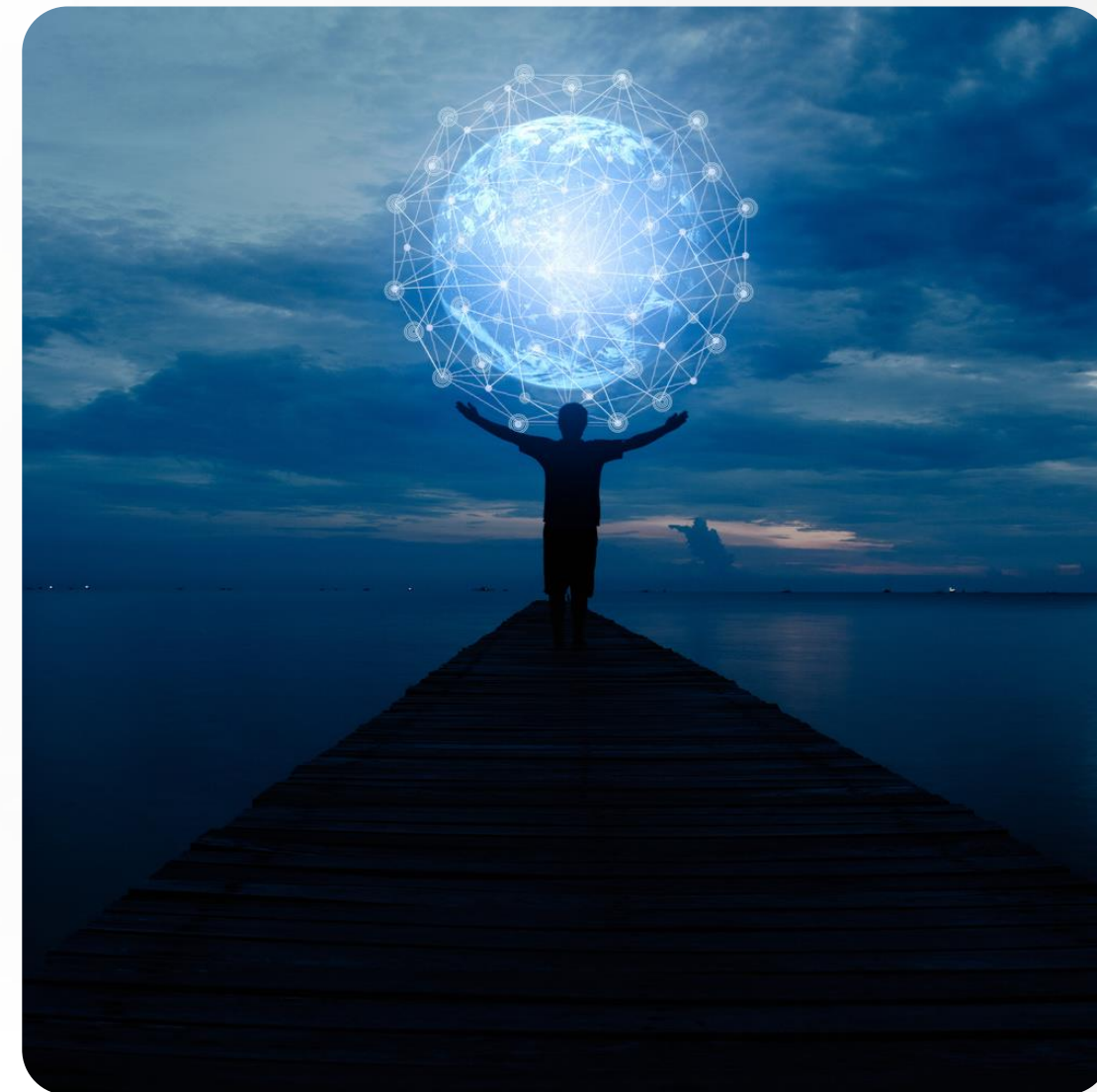


2. Lucidity

3. Concreteness

The number of quantifiable elements and degree of quantification in those elements.

**For example, in the case of a business:
Revenues, Profits, expansion, employee strength, number of countries, etc.**

**For example, in the case of personal health:
Weight, waist, Pulse, cholesterol, Sugar, BP, etc.**

4. Complexity

How complex or simple is the main concept behind the vision?

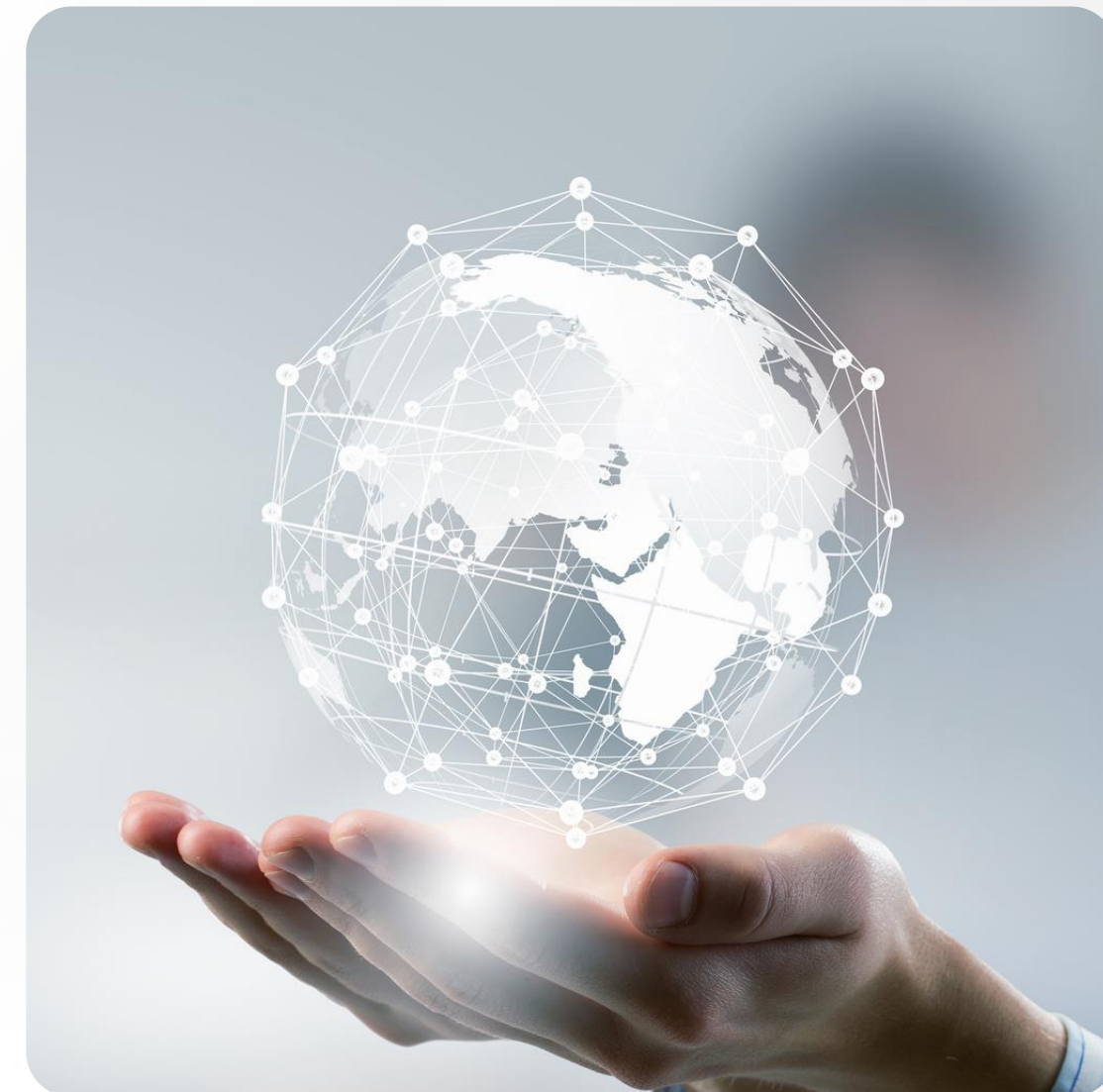
5. Scale
